

Town of Lewisville Agreement for Display of Artwork

- 1. The display and organization of pieces of the artwork shall be subject to the approval of the Town. The Public Art Advisory Committee will jury the artwork to ensure the artwork is appropriate for a family environment. The jury process will also consider the quality of the artwork and how many (if any) pieces can be displayed based on the space limitations and number of entries from other artists.
- 2. The artist will be responsible for his/her own artwork including any damage, theft, or personal injury. The Town of Lewisville is not able to provide insurance on property it does not own.
- 3. The ownership of the artwork shall remain with the artist.

Town Manager or Designee Signature

- 4. The Town does not permit the sale of any artwork while on the premises. The Town also will not act as a sales agent and prices may not be posted on artwork while on display. If the artist does sell a piece while on display, the artwork may not be removed before the close of the exhibition.
- 5. The artist shall deliver the artwork to the Mary Alice Warren Community Center on February 7, 2024 (2:00-7:00 p.m.); the Exhibition shall end on March 9, 2024; and the artwork shall be picked up on March 11, 2024 (2:00-7:00 p.m.). If the artwork is not picked up March 11, 2024, or other arrangements made by the artist, then the artwork will become the property of the Town.
- 6. The Town may publicize the artists and the artwork through one or more media types for promotional or other related purposes.
