

## SPECIAL PROJECTS REVIEW COMMITTEE Meeting Minutes August 7, 2025

I. Call to Order – Councilmember Welch called the meeting to order at 5:15 PM. Committee members present were Mayor Pro-Tem Melissa Hunt, Councilmembers Ivan Huffman and Jane Welch. Town Clerk Angie Lord was also in attendance.

## II. Approval of Minutes

- A. <u>April 24, 2025</u> Councilmember Welch made a motion to approve the meeting minutes of April 24, 2025. Councilmember Huffman seconded the motion and motion passed unanimously.
- B. July 21, 2025 Councilmember Welch made a motion to approve the meeting minutes of July 21, 2025. Councilmember Huffman seconded the motion and motion passed unanimously.

## III. Requests:

A. <u>Crosby Scholars</u> – Town Clerk Angie Lord provided a handout for the updated request; a brief history for a request from the Crosby Scholars Community Partnership; explained the denial of the request previously due to an incomplete application; and that the group had resubmitted the application with additional information. The group has requested a facility use exemption to utilize the Mary Alice Warren Community Center in the Shallowford room and kitchen for a staff retreat on August 14, 2025.

Councilmember Huffman reiterated previous concerns with the incomplete application; the organizations budgetary information; the group meeting only one of five criteria; and the waste of taxpayer dollars. Mayor Pro-Tem Hunt echoed concerns voiced.

Councilmember Welch stated a leaning to approve the request based on the history of the organization in the school system and communities.

Mayor Pro-Tem Hunt made a motion to recommend denial of the request to Council. Motion was seconded by Councilmember Huffman and passed 2-1 with Councilmember Welch voting in opposition.

Staff will present the Committee's recommendation to Council during the August briefing session being held later this day.

B. Lewisville United Methodist Preschool (LUMC Preschool) – Town Clerk Lord provided a handout for the request; explained the request for a one-time exemption from the LUMC Preschool for a facility exemption request on either December 11<sup>th</sup> or December 9<sup>th</sup> for a staff Christmas party at the Mary Alice Warren Community Center (MAWCC); and stated the Preschool had been approved last year for an exemption.

Discussion took place regarding the Preschool Board Chair as a former Councilmember; and the need for an up-to-date Certificate of Liability before use of the space.

Councilmember Huffman made a motion to approve the one-time facility use exemption of the MAWCC in the Shallowford room and kitchen on either December 11<sup>th</sup> or December 9<sup>th</sup>, based on availability for a Preschool Staff Christmas party. The motion was seconded by Mayor Pro-Tem Hunt and passed unanimously.

Staff will present the Committee's recommendation for approval to Council during the August briefing session being held later this day.

**C. Adjournment** – Having no other requests or business to discuss, Councilmember Welch moved to adjourn the meeting at 5:27 PM. The motion was seconded by Mayor Pro-Tem Hunt and passed unanimously.
