

LEWISVILLE PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

November 1, 2022

- I. **Call to Order** - Chair Cobert called the meeting to order at 5:31 PM. In attendance were Harlan Cobert, Chris Cobert, Robert Fitzpatrick, Aaron Hutmacher, Warren McMahan, Annemarie Stanford, Lewisville Fire Chief Darin Needham, Vienna Fire Chief Tim Lasley. There was no representation from the Forsyth County Sheriff's Office.
- II. **Agenda Approval** – Chris Cobert moved to approve the agenda. The motion was seconded by Annemarie Stanford and motion was approved unanimously.
- III. **Minutes Approval** – Chris Cobert moved to approve the October 4, 2022 minutes as presented. The motion was seconded by Warren McMahan and motion was approved unanimously.
- IV. **Public Safety Reports**
 - A. Forsyth County Sheriff's Office – None
 - B. Lewisville Fire Department – The department is working with LEAP, Forsyth Tech and Insight to possibly develop a fire apprentice program with discussion focused on job skills. They are also working with other agencies related to the high school academy. A new generator is on its way. The new brush truck chassis has been built and is hoped to be in service December-January. Conrad Road is still a concern in terms of accidents. The LUCAS CPR device will be placed in service November 7 after all personnel are trained.
 - C. Vienna Fire Department – The new tanker will be delivered in February instead of November. The department's insurance inspection will be November 21. The City of Winston-Salem is considering placing an engine company at Station 20.

 - A. Emergency Operations Plan Update – An update was given on the progress of the plan noting the goal is to have it completed by December.
 - B. Emergency communications systems – The subcommittee members are working on their assignments. All of the 2005/2006 system information was located.
