- A. Forsyth County Sheriff's Office

The department will be doing a welcoming water curtain on August 23rd to welcome the students. They are working on their inspection rating that should be ready either at the end of the year or beginning of next year. Ratings are 1 (best) to 10 (worst). Vienna is rated as 3 and Lewisville is rated at 2.
