Bulky Item Pick Up

Bulky items such as carpet, white goods, furniture, mattresses, and other approved items on this list will be picked up by Waste Management only during the scheduled week advertised by the Town.

If you have questions about bulky item collection, call 945-5558.

- Waste Management trucks will go through your neighborhood only <u>ONCE</u>. <u>Items placed at</u> the curb after the crews pass will not be collected.
- Items should be placed at the curb by 6:00 a.m. the Monday of the designated week.
- Do not mix bulky items with yard waste, recyclables, solid waste, clothing, shoes or brush.
- Items that Waste Management can collect include: mattresses (limit 2 sets), white goods (stoves, refrigerators, freezers, washers & dryers), toilets, furniture, carpet and large toys. <u>CALL IF YOU HAVE QUESTIONS!</u>
- Items not acceptable for collection include: electronic waste, yard waste, wood, lumber, building material, glass, tires, car parts, paint, oil drums, cement, rocks, liquid waste, bags or bagged/boxed/containerized trash, batteries, motor oil, dead animals, chemicals, cardboard, construction debris, lawn mowers, clothing/shoes, equipment containing gas/oil, and hazardous or medical waste. THIS LIST IS NOT ALL INCLUSIVE, CALL IF YOU HAVE OUESTIONS!!
 - PLEASE NOTE: televisions and computers and related computer equipment are banned from landfills in North Carolina. This includes CPUs, laptops, monitors, printers, printer/fax/scan devices, mice and keyboards; and all televisions, including flat-panel televisions, projection televisions and televisions with picture tubes. These items should be taken to 3RC Enviro-Station, 1401 S. Martin Luther King Jr. Drive, Winston-Salem. Hours of operation are Tuesday-Friday, 9a.m. - 2p.m. and Saturday 9a.m. -12 noon, phone 336-784-4300.
- Collectible bulky items mixed with uncollectible items will not be removed.
- Bulky item collection is for single family residences, <u>NOT</u> businesses or apartments.
- Other than the scheduled neighborhood pickups, residents should dispose of these items at the Hanes Mill Road Landfill. Landfill hours of operation are Monday through Friday, 7 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. and Saturday, 8 a.m. to 12 p.m.
